

## **Third Street Program**

# Please carefully read the following information before completing this application

Third Street provides affordable housing and services to support moms in pursuing goals, accessing resources and in providing a healthy stable home for their children.

Third Street is a starting place for single moms (18 years and older) with one or two children under the age of five years old or women in their last trimester of pregnancy.

- Moms must have full or partial, at least 50% of the time, custody of child(ren) to be eligible.
  Losing custody of your child(ren) will make you ineligible for housing in a YWCA Madison family program.
- Interested applicants must have a source of income.

Third Street has 18 apartments located on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th floors of the YWCA at 101 East Mifflin Street. Apartments are furnished and include use of hallway phones and voicemail. Rents for a one bedroom starts at \$485.00 and goes up depending on availability. Cable television is provided in shared lounges but is not available in apartments. **Off-street parking is NOT offered** by the YWCA. Parking can be very difficult and expensive. There is good bus access on the Capital Square.

<u>Section 8</u>: Vouchers are available for some Third Street units. <u>Current Third Street families are given priority for Section 8 units.</u> Section 8 is offered to those in good standing with the program and those able to meet CDA and HUD screening criteria.

#### **Third Street Participation Requirements**

To be eligible for the Third Street Program, applicants must meet the criteria listed above and the following program requirements once approved for housing at YWCA Madison:

- Being a part of Third Street requires you to attend case management to identify goals in areas of self reliance, education, housing and parenting
- Participation in program community events and activities
- Cooperate with and assist Third Street Staff and/or YWCA Madison Landlord to comply with grant obligations and reporting requirements, including but not limited to: reporting household size, demographics, income, etc.
- Be in compliance with YWCA Madison Lease and Resident + Program Handbooks
